This is in addition to our two other previously beatified individuals, Blessed Hippee Jack (Vernon) Brashear, and his loving wife, Blessed Susan Brashear. Blessed Hippee Jack's feast day is the day after St. Pierre's, April 20th, while Blessed Susan's is April 11th.
